Denver, CO: Rocky Mountain Region Federal Employees, Military Personnel, retirees, contractor personnel (employed by the military or Federal agencies), and their families are invited to participate in the 25th running of the Denver Federal Cup 5K Walk/Run. This event will be held at the Denver Federal Center, 6th and Kipling, on May 17, 2008. Entry fee is \$8 per person to pre-register (\$10 on race day) and the Kid's 1K Fun Run is free. This unique event is held every year on Armed Forces Day to give recognition to the contributions of the Federal and Military communities, as well as provide a day of family fun and lively competition. The Federal Cup features a 5 Kilometer Road Race, 5 Kilometer Race Walk, and 1 Kilometer Fun Run for kids. Individual awards will be presented to the winners of each race category and everyone can enjoy the free food, music, and door prizes donated by area merchants and race sponsors.

This year the Fed Cup is celebrating its 25 running. Special events, food, and gifts are all planned to make this year's race one to remember!

Each Federal agency and military branch is encouraged to enter as a team. Teams will compete for the ultimate prize, the Fed Cup! The Fed Cup is a traveling trophy that goes to the fastest team each year. This year, for the very first time, a Fed Cup just for the race walking team participants will be awarded. Other team awards are in the following categories: Men's Team-all male; Women's Team-all female; Co-Ed Team (at least 1 member of each gender); Masters Team-age 40+, and Race-walking Team, any gender composition. Teams must have a minimum of four members.

There will be individual awards for runners and race walkers for the top three overall male and female finishers as well as awards for the top three male and female finishers in each age group in the running category.
